UPRIGAZ is fully supportive of ENTSOG's activities and considers that the AWP 2020 adequately identifies the main areas of concern and interest of the gas business and operations.

For UPRIGAZ, it is essential to foster the development of interconnected market places across Europe. Therefore a special focus should address the following issues:

- congestion management at the interface of regional networks,
- harmonization of transmission tariff at cross border points with an adaptation of IT systems.

For UPRIGAZ, the updated of the TYNDP in 2020 is a major milestone for the future of EU gas industry in a new context marked by two main elements :

- a decline in the EU domestic production,
- a series of options for future natural gas in LNG imports

Since it is vital that the transmission cost of gas remain as low as possible, the ten YNDP should analyze and rank such options, both on a technical and economic point of views.
